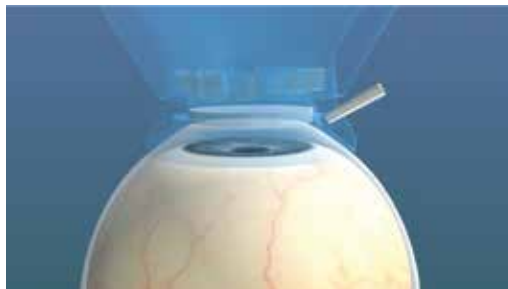
Why is My Vision- Changing?



As we grow older, the natural lens inside the eye becomes less flexible and less able to change shape not allowing us to see clearly at both distance and near. The condition is a natural change that affects everyone beginning in their 40's and is called presbyopia. Many of us recognize this when it becomes difficult to see clearly at near without reading glasses.

The Procedure

VIS Optimal Keratoplasty (Opti-K™) is performed outside the visual zone (where you actually “see”).



Using two concentric rings of laser energy delivered outside the visual zone of the eye, Opti-K™ applies mild heat in 16 spots to change the shape of the cornea. Opti-K™ is minimally invasive — no tissue is cut or removed.
